Headteacher's Comments

Welcome back everyone! We hope you had an enjoyable half term holiday and are looking forward to the term ahead.

We have an exciting half term planned with lots of events and trips at school, including our annual sports day events so let's all keep our fingers crossed for good weather. New dates have been added to the calendar section on the reverse side of the newsletter.

Important Message

We continue to work tirelessly to support our families to ensure children attend school regularly. However, as you can see by the attendance summary below, our attendance is continuing to cause serious concern. The past two weeks of term we were far below our target at 88.1%. So far this week this has further declined to 86%. As noted in previous newsletters, if attendance fails to improve the school will be issued with serious sanctions which would be a terrible shame when we have made excellent improvements in all other areas. We have been left with no choice but to issue a total of 23 Fixed Penalty Notices (with fines) for persistent absenteeism (including holidays taken in term time).

In the mornings, an average of 50 children are brought in late which has a serious effect on your child's learning and causes significant disruption. Please, please, PLEASE support us in improving attendance and punctuality.

Thank you all for your continuing support, including our recent Cystic Fibrosis awareness day on the last day of term. We are thrilled to announce that we raised £194.86 which will go to the CF Trust.
